Year to date earnings from commissions are approximately \$6000. Our Grand Danube program in August 2014 had 22 paying participants, thus we were able to invite Professor Diane Ketelle to join us. While onboard she lectured on the Circus in Eastern Europe and Women's Fashion Under Communism. We were the largest group from any of the participating colleges.
