- 1. Travel Committee members met on November 9 with VP, Sales, AHI Agency to discuss selected trips for 2022:
 - Wonders of Peru
 - Alaskan Heritage & Wildlife (Anchorage, Denali)
 - New Orleans, The African American Experience
 - Japan
 - United Arab Emirates, featuring the Dubai Expo
 - The Charm of the Amalfi Coast
 - Spain ~ Andalucia in a Parador
- 2. The committee met on November 19 to review and finalize 2022 Gohagan trips, and discussed selected trips with the Director of Sales, Gohagan Travel on December 10.
 - Treasures of Caribbean (Barbados, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Martinique, Isles des Santes, Saint Lucia)
 - New Zealand
 - Scottish Isles and Norwegian Fjords
 - Changing Tides of History Baltic Sea (Sweden, Denmark, Russia, Poland)
 - Ancient Civilizations Adriatic & Aegean Odyssey (Italy, Greece, Croatia, Albania)
 - Cruising the Great Lakes
- 3. We continue to monitor 2021 trip cancellations and potential cancellations. No one had signed up for any of these trips yet, so Mills commissions were not affected.
- 4. The travel survey closed on 12/4/20, with **131 respondents.** The survey results will be ready to be presented to the BOG at the next meeting.
- 5. We continue to explore possibilities and costs of more local and domestic trips (e.g. day trips in the greater Bay Area).
