**Activities:**

1. Travel Committee members met on November 9 with VP, Sales, AHI Agency to discuss selected trips for 2022:
  - Wonders of Peru
  - Alaskan Heritage & Wildlife (Anchorage, Denali)
  - New Orleans, The African American Experience
  - Japan
  - United Arab Emirates, featuring the Dubai Expo
  - The Charm of the Amalfi Coast
  - Spain ~ Andalucia in a Parador
  
2. The committee met on November 19 to review and finalize 2022 Gohagan trips, and discussed selected trips with the Director of Sales, Gohagan Travel on December 10.
  - Treasures of Caribbean (Barbados, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Martinique, Isles des Santes, Saint Lucia)
  - New Zealand
  - Scottish Isles and Norwegian Fjords
  - Changing Tides of History - Baltic Sea (Sweden, Denmark, Russia, Poland)
  - Ancient Civilizations - Adriatic & Aegean Odyssey (Italy, Greece, Croatia, Albania)
  - Cruising the Great Lakes
  
3. We continue to monitor 2021 trip cancellations and potential cancellations. No one had signed up for any of these trips yet, so Mills commissions were not affected.
  
4. The travel survey closed on 12/4/20, with **131 respondents**. The survey results will be ready to be presented to the BOG at the next meeting.
  
5. We continue to explore possibilities and costs of more local and domestic trips (e.g. day trips in the greater Bay Area).
